One is for the Broncos and one is for the Chiefs. The new one zips. It is blue and has pockets.




## These items are both used for going to the bathroom.

They have different movies. One is flat and one is large. One of them you just put in and it begins. The other one you have to pick the channels.




# These items are both used for solving math problems.
